



## **SiBEAM, Inc. Finalist for 2008 Andrew Seybold Choice Award**

*Omilink60™ Wireless Semiconductor Technology Recognized in Most Innovative New  
Concept Design Category*

**SUNNYVALE, California – March 12, 2008** - SiBEAM, Inc., a leading innovator of millimeter wave (mmWave) semiconductor solutions and developer of high-speed wireless communications platforms was recognized as a 2008 Andrew Seybold Choice Award finalist for its Omnilink60™ technology. Standing out over 150 entries received from around the world, SiBEAM's Omnilink60 technology will compete in the "Most Innovative New Concept Design" category.

The 2008 Andrew Seybold Choice Awards honor the most innovative wireless mobility products and concepts and their positive impact in the world of wireless mobility connectivity. Each nominated company or product is judged, evaluated and selected based on a defined set of criteria. The Andrew Seybold Choice Award winners will be named on April 1, 2008, at the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Andrew Seybold Wireless Dinner at CTIA Wireless 2008 in Las Vegas.

SiBEAM was the first to break the barriers of 60 GHz technology with the development of working 60 GHz chipsets for non-line-of-sight applications built using standard CMOS manufacturing techniques. In January 2008, SiBEAM announced the world's first WirelessHD Chipset Solutions, built in affordable CMOS. These chipsets, based on its award-winning OmniLink60 wireless semiconductor technology, are the first to deliver true, lossless uncompressed A/V at 1080p, the preferred choice of consumer electronics manufacturers. The WirelessHD specification simplifies the set-up and management of a wireless video area network (WVAN) which can consist of a variety of WirelessHD-enabled devices including a high-definition television, high-definition disc player, digital video recorder, digital video camera, digital A/V player and more, by using only one A/V controller.

This is the latest industry recognition received by SiBEAM. In February 2008, SiBEAM was again included in EE Times' 60 Emerging Start-ups List. In late 2007, SiBEAM was awarded the GSA Fabless Start-Up to Watch Award and the 2008 Consumer Electronics Show (CES) "Best of Innovations" award in the enabling technologies category. The company has also received the Silicon Valley Business Journal Emerging Technology Award and has been named an AlwaysOn 100 Top Private Company.
